



The Imagination Workshop – Workshop Overview

The Imagination Workshop draws on two main elements:

- My Journey via asthma into writing and creating characters and setting scenes.
- My fantasy series for children: The Peck Chronicles.

The session is designed to be very interactive (lots of questions for the children), educational and fun. Children hear about the ‘Snakes and Ladders’ in my life that led me to write my first book. More importantly, they get to create their own creature-character, drawing this with their classmates and attributing characteristics.

– *This can be done as an assembly presentation, where I draw the creature the children create - (15 – 30 minutes) or as below – I run a class workshop (50-60 minutes).*

Ideally this session would be followed up by the ‘Window on Another World’ workshop – which takes the character/creature that the children have designed goes on to look at dialogue and setting the scene. The session also looks at the fantasy world of the Peck Series (how I made that world come alive) and at the real ‘Lost World’ that I found while working in Indonesia.

Part 1 (suitable for 8 – 12 years; 25 mins)

- I introduce myself and tell the children how the various elements of my life effected my writing. (Working with bears, playing in rock bands)
- I ask the children if they know anyone who has asthma and talk about the affliction that, in it’s own strange way, led me to write my first book.
- I explain what asthma is and talk about managing the disease and doing great things despite it. Just like James Peck in the Peck Chronicles.
- I set the scene for the book and tell the children how it begins... Reading 1 plus questions.
- I tell them about my son Ryan wanting new and strange new creatures in the story.

Part 2 (suitable for 8 – 12 years; 25 mins)

- I talk about the fantasy world of Talisman, and how there are some creatures they will recognise and others they won’t.
- I tell the children the ‘trick’ I use to come up with new creatures.
- We design a creature between us and draw it.

- We roll out a large strip of wallpaper, or two strips – depending on the size of the group, and the teachers position the children around the rolled-out paper.
- They each find a space on the paper and begin to draw the new creature the class has formed. Thinking about description, how it might behave, how it might sound, dialogue etc
- After ten minutes, we review and talk about Imagination and how - even though they've been sitting right next to each other – they have still drawn different versions of the same creature. I relate this to books and libraries etc. And finally, to THE PECK CHRONICLES. I show them three creatures from the series and do a second reading, where the children have to repeat certain sounds and words.
- We review what we have discovered during the session. Using a flip-chart we list what they have learned.

Question Time (Suitable for 8 – 12 years; 5 mins)

If we are moving onto the 'Window on another World' workshop - I tell them about the next session to come.

Equipment needed

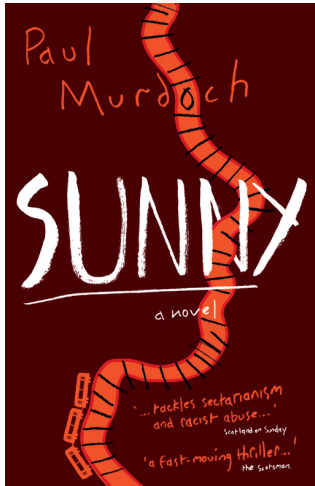
- Ample space – for children to work either side of some rolled out wallpaper. *If multiple classes are going to be seen, it is better to have them come into one single area, with everything all set up. But I can 'work around' this if space is not possible.*
- Flipchart and marker
- Screen, white wall or link to a display system. I have my own projector and use a Mac Air.

Sunny - Luck seems to be on young Sunny Wilson's side when he survives a major road accident. But was he meant to walk away? Sunny is convinced someone has it in for him – a sense strengthened when an attempt is made to abduct him from hospital. Once out, Sunny is faced with his town's ongoing sectarian divisions. They boil over when someone attacks a train carrying pupils from a rival school. Sunny knows the culprit's identity, but the risks of revealing it are high. All Sunny's troubles seem to stem back to the crash. So, he follows a hunch to try to solve that mystery...and finds his life in peril all over again. Talisman – Book 1 of ‘The Peck Chronicles’. James Peck’s father is missing and he sets off to find him with the help of some very strange creatures. An exciting fantasy adventure full magic, monsters, courage, determination and family. James has to find the Talisman of Denthan if he has to have any chance of stopping the evil wizard Dendralon and finding his father, but no one knows what it looks like. (Ages: 7-14 / Themes: quest story, magic, monsters, adventure, mystery, fantasy, family tensions, morals, /Price: £6.50. Bulk discounts available)

Citadel – Book 2 of ‘The Peck Chronicles’. James Peck, battles his way through a dying world in an effort to stop a Hedra wizard from saving his own kind at the expense of all others.
